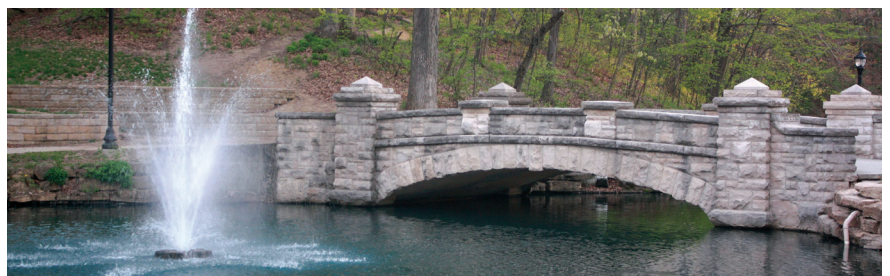

The Generations Tree Program is a cooperative program between the Springfield Parks Foundation and the Springfield Park District. It was created to provide an opportunity for individuals, families, businesses and groups to establish a living, long-lasting and beautiful tribute for someone they wish to honor.

The SPF is dedicated to preserving and restoring native vegetation within our parks. We work with the Springfield Park District Arborist to establish an approved tree list that meets restoration criteria.

## Memorial Bench Program

Our Memorial Bench Program offers the opportunity to purchase a custom historic designed black metal bench with a brass placard for engraving. These benches can be seen throughout our park system and create a dedicated space to commemorate a special person in your life or celebrate a special event with a Memorial Park Bench. The benches serve as a beautiful lasting remembrance that will benefit the community for years.

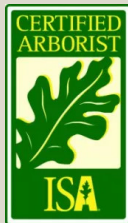

## TREE OR BENCH ORDER FORM

### Memorial Tree or Bench Terms & Conditions -

1. The District Arborist or their designated staff reserves the right to select the location and species of a memorial tree and/or bench in the selected park or property. Springfield Park District staff will work with the person purchasing the memorial to find a mutually agreeable tree species and bench location where applicable.
2. Scheduling of the tree planting also will be at the discretion of the Park District Arborist or their designated staff. Springfield Park District will work with the person purchasing the memorial to find a mutually agreeable date for either the Spring or Fall Season.
3. A \$200 donation per tree will be applied to the purchase of the tree(s), it's planting and initial maintenance. A \$1,500 donation will be applied to the purchase of a memorial bench, memorial inscription, installation and initial maintenance.
4. The District shall use best management practices to assist the memorial tree so that it survives and thrives. However, the District does not guarantee that a memorial tree will survive or be damaged due to natural disaster, disease or pestilence..
