The Springfield Park District has dredged and relined the lagoon, completed work on the two waterfalls in the lagoon, added stone outcropping around the perimeter of the entire lagoon, and restored the iconic bridge that spans the lagoon. This project has made great strides towards enhancing Lincoln Park for all to enjoy.
